

Karin Simpson Memorial Scholarship for Creativity

Karin Simpson was one of the founding members of the Creative Airdrie Society. She had a very strong passion for the arts, having previously served on the board of the Alberta Foundation for the Arts and as a member of the City of Airdrie Community Advisory Board. Karen passed away in 2014. The board of Creative Airdrie voted unanimously to create a scholarship in her honour.

The scholarship is intended for a graduating student of the Rocky View District school who has been accepted in to post-secondary education in the arts in any field including but not limited to visual arts, drama, music, musical theatre, film, new media, literature, design and dance.

One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to the most eligible candidate.

Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- o be a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident,
- be an Alberta resident the applicant or the applicant's parent(s) must have resided in Alberta during the qualifying grades,
- o have completed the requirements for high school graduation in Alberta,
- graduating from a school with the Rocky View District (both public and Catholic high school)
- plan to enroll full-time in an accredited Alberta post-secondary institution, and entering the first year of a degree or diploma program in a field of study supporting the arts and culture industry including but not limited to: visual arts, drama, music, musical theatre, film, new media, literature, design and dance.
- demonstrate outstanding qualities in their chosen artistic field with academic excellence and involvement in school and extra-curricular activities

Note: Relatives of the CAS board of directors are not eligible.

Selection: The Creative Airdrie Board of Directors with Sheila Watson (Karin's sister) will select an award recipient based on a combination of academic achievement, artistic merit, school involvement and community service.

Announcement: Award recipient is announced May

Disbursement: The award is disbursed in September once confirmation of full-time enrollment in post-secondary studies is provided.
